2008-09 Policies

Classes

- **Tiny Tot** is for children 6 and under. Children are ready to skate as soon as they can walk. We teach your skater both safety and basic skills for the sport of Roller Skating. The class will participate in a choreographed number in our semi-annual Performance. Class is Saturday 12:00–12:45 PM.
- **Drill** is synchronized skating using a combination of formations to create images of art for the performance. This group will develop strong Teamwork. The class will participate in a choreographed number in our semi-annual Performance. Class is Friday 5:15-6:15 PM.
- **Dance** utilizes the art of rhythmic movement on roller skates to create unique performances. The class will participate in a choreographed number in our semi-annual Performance. Class is Tuesday 5:30-6:30 PM.
- **Advanced Dance** utilizes the art of rhythmic movement on roller skates to create unique performances. This class is for skaters with advanced skating skills. Skaters must take Dance class in the same season as the advanced dance class. The class will participate in a choreographed number in our semi-annual Performance. Class is Friday 6:15-7:15 PM
- **Singles** uses the art of jumping and spinning combined with the skills learned in dance and drill to create an extreme performance. The class will participate in a choreographed number in our semi-annual Performance. Class is Saturday 4:00-5:00 PM.
- **Conditioning** is necessary for you to perform at your optimum level. Sport specific movements that create physical stress on the body are conditioning. Health is a state of complete mental, physical and social well being where as fitness is the ability to meet the demands of a physical task. Exercise scientists have identified nine components that comprise the definition of fitness. These involve Strength, Power, Agility, Balance, Flexibility, Local Muscle Endurance, Cardiovascular Endurance, Strength Endurance, and Coordination. Classes are Friday 4:45-5:15 PM and Saturday 12:45-1:15 PM.

Tuition

- A \$25.00 1st member, \$15.00 additional member, registration fee is required to hold a group space.
- Tuition is based on the full Session (9 months - September through May) and is divided into 9 equal payments for your convenience. It is the same for a long month (5 class weeks) or a short month (3 class weeks) and regardless of absence or holidays. **ALL TUITION IS DUE IN ADVANCE AND DUE THE 1ST CLASS OF EACH MONTH. If tuition is not received by the 7th of each month, a \$20.00 late fee is incurred.** All accounts must be paid up-to-date to participate in performances or outside group activities. Any unpaid tuition or late fees must be paid before you receive your costumes for the Performance. You may pay your tuition in full upon registration. Paying in full upon registration will give you a 5% discount.
- **The costume package for each performance will average \$75.00 per number. This includes all accessories and props.** For your convenience, we have split the costume fee into two installments. Holiday Performance 1st installment of \$35.00 with October Tuition and the 2nd installment, and balance, with November Tuition. Costumes not paid in full by November 7th will not be ordered. May Performance 1st installment of \$35.00 with January Tuition and the 2nd installment, and balance, with March Tuition. Costumes not paid in full by March 7th will not be ordered.
- NSF Fee is \$25.00 on each and every returned check. Please be aware that an NSF check may cause a late fee if funds are not received by the 7th. NSF Fee and any Late Fees will be paid first.
- Additional Family members will receive a 30% discount. The discount will be applied to the lowest tuition.
- The Saturday Public Skating Matinee 1:30 – 4:00 PM session is included in the Monthly fee. Skaters are encouraged to utilize this time for socializing and additional practice. All fees and tuition must be current to utilize this privilege.

Semi-Annual Performance

- Scheduled for December 13 & 14, 2008 and Sunday, May 30 & 31, 2009.
- There will be a Cast Party following the Holiday Performance. Every skater will receive a complimentary ticket. You may purchase additional tickets for guests. The After Party for this season will be December 13, 2008.
- There will be a Cast Party following the May Performance. Every skater will receive a complimentary ticket. You may purchase additional tickets for guests. The After Party for this season will be May 31, 2009. All participants will receive an award for participating in the season.
- Soloists will need to book private choreography lessons (\$60.00/hr). There is a \$25.00 Performance fee for any approved solos. All Soloists must sell a total of 15 tickets to the Performance.

Attendance

- When you enroll in a group, you are paying to hold a spot for your skater. **Tuition cannot be pro-rated or refunded for absences.** If the Skating School is cancelled due to bad weather, there will be a make-up class provided.
- **Good Attendance is Imperative:** Attendance is taken for each class or activity. The class is constructed to help skaters attain their greatest success and beginning on time is imperative.
- The school must be notified in writing if a student must add/drop/change a class after enrollment.

Standards of Behavior

- All skaters are required to adhere to the dress code.
- **Dress Code** will be form fitting clothes that allow complete movement. Skaters should wear skating outfits or a form fitting T-shirt and shorts. White sole sneakers are needed for off skates training. The sneakers must only be worn at skating school.
- Every student is encouraged to have their own skates. Ask for Coach Tony's assistance when buying your skates at our skate shop.
- The Skating School or Semoran Skateway will not be held responsible for any lost or stolen items. Lockers are available for \$0.50 per use, or \$5.00 per month to Skating School Students on a first come first serve basis.
- Label all shoes and belongings in order to prevent confusion among students.
- Please enter the Skating School quietly. You must check in every time you arrive, and then go to the benches along the side wall to put on your skates. All skate bags must be zipped up and standing on end before you enter the skating surface.
- **ALL FOOD AND DRINK MUST BE KEPT IN THE SNACK BAR AREA. NO GUM CHEWING IS PERMITTED ANYWHERE IN THE BUILDING.**

Medical

- All skaters must report any and all personal medical conditions during the Registration Process.
- Any injury during participation of class or activity must be reported to the staff immediately.
- Any medical expenses incurred will be the responsibility of the skater. All skaters skate at their own risk. We do not have medical insurance.
